Advisory: CRIME ALERT – Recent Residential Burglaries in RD29

1400 BLOCK OF IRVINE AVE -Two neighboring homes were burglarized
(18-00018 & 18-00019)

Occurred on: 1/1/2018 between 12:00 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.

While the victims were out, an unknown suspect entered the victim's backyard through an unsecured side gate, walked around to the back of the house and shattered the sliding glass door leading into the living room. Once inside, the suspect ransacked the living room, master bedroom and cabinets, storage areas and closets in three other rooms of the home. The suspect removed the listed property and then fled out the side garage door.

The suspect then removed two fence boards from the fence that separates the neighboring home, near the garage door. The suspect proceeded across that backyard to the living room sliding glass door and shattered that door. Once inside, the suspect again ransacked all of the bedrooms. The suspect located the victim's car keys and fled in the victim's Jeep Cherokee that had been parked in the garage.

Loss: Passport and laptop (18-00019) Jeep Cherokee, additional items may have been taken, but unknown at the time of this report (18-00018)

Suspect Information: None seen or heard.

2100 BLOCK OF HIGHLAND DR (17-10714)

Occurred on: 12/28/2017 at 6:30 a.m.

While the victims were out of town, an unknown suspect entered the victim's secured backyard after possibly climbing over one of two locked gates. The suspect then shattered a window pane on a sliding glass door near the lock.

The suspect then reached in through the hole, unlocked the sliding glass door and opened it. Before the burglar could get the door open far enough to enter, the burglar alarm was activated and the suspect fled. When officers arrived they found no evidence that the suspect had entered the home.

Add 16 drops (1/4 teaspoon) of unscented bleach per gallon of water

Easy to store, hard to carry



Samson 5 gal stackable ~\$25
Rigid to store, easier to carry

North Star Clubhouse CERT Suggestions

Consider these for any extensive house remodel too.

General Requirements

Earthquake safe to 7.9

Fire safe

Slab >3 ft above high tide for tsunامي and sea level rise

Everything ADA compliant especially bathrooms and shower

Unisex bathrooms

Electrical

Off-grid capable with transfer switch for critical loads - refrigerator

Hybrid natural gas / propane fixed generator

Solar array - [Tesla solar roof?](#)

[Storage battery](#)

Multiple AC outlets in CERT area for radios etc

Communications

Projection TV

Multiple TV's - eg sports bar

Cable TV and Internet

Secure mounting for current satellite Internet antenna

Satellite TV option

High speed Internet wiring outlets

Telescoping radio antenna tower with cable access & routing

[Cell phone booster](#)

CERT General

[Flow-through water storage](#) > 1000 gallons with pressure pump

Hose bibs access to water storage for distribution / truck refill

External gasoline / propane fuel storage for portable generators

Propane tank for generator and cooking

Miscellaneous

Heat pumps rather than basic AC for weather extremes

High efficiency heat-pump style water heater

Convertible natural gas / propane cook top

Earthquake gas shut-off valve

Natural lighting: windows/skylight/solar tube in closed areas

Exterior LED flood lights for night operations / triage
