(Southern) San Andreas Fault

Earthquakes often preceded by clusters - Southern San Andreas only makes big ones

On average it slips every 200 years - last in 1680 (330 years ago - no one knows why)

Likely magnitude 7.8 - 8.2

Likely to shake for 50-60 seconds (Northridge was 7 seconds, 6.7 magnitude)

Likely to shift 20-30 feet sideways - length of moving fault ~200 miles to Mexico to SLO

Expect more than 10,000 aftershocks - some large

Scenario Modeled:

10% of new buildings red tagged, 1% partial collapse

In LA area 300,000 structures with severe damage, 1500 structures collapsed

53,000 casualties need hospitalization 1,800 deaths

1600 fires - 1200 large enough for multiple engines

Key Messages from *The Big Ones*

Earthquakes, volcanoes, floods are natural events with predictable frequency and size range

On average for each mag 8 there are 10x mag 7s, 100x mag 6s, 1000x mag 5s etc

Humans turn natural events into disasters by how we deal with them

Not a disaster if we plan and prepare for them

People tend to plan for what they have experienced, not what is possible

Human behaviors are consistent

People need to assign blame - usually to someone beside themselves

Blame is often assigned to "others" - minorities

Retribution is quick and often brutal

The poor suffer more than the rich

Disasters are measured by how we respond to natural events

Impacts last months or even years

The event is just the beginning of the response

People remember the event but not the response

San Andreas Earthquake - Impact on Dover Shores

1% collapse, 10% red-tag => Dover Shores: 3 collapse, 30 red-tagged

Where would we house 33 families?


Gas and electric out for 30 days

Cooking, phones, medical support?

Water, sewer out for 30 days - potentially 6 months

Water distribution, toilets?

Business impacts - how would people pay the rent?

[Crime and break ins](#)

In view of the many break-ins occurring at residential homes around NB, Officer Chris Kimball of the NBPD made points at a recent meeting: - We can protect ourselves by knowing our neighbors and their habits. Let your immediate neighbors know when you are going out of town.

- Immediately call the police non-emergency dispatch (949.644.3717) if you see or hear anything suspicious [note: you can call 911 if it is an emergency but sometimes those calls get routed to California Highway Patrol]. Do not approach a suspicious person – let the police handle it. Suspicious activity can include an overly dressed person on a hot day, a person sitting in their car using their cell phone or computer (could be the lookout and tipping off accomplices), a strange noise that could resemble glass breaking or a large bag of ice falling, a Mercedes or other nice car with paper plates rather a license plate.

- The most vulnerable time is between 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. Keep lights and televisions on while you are out to dinner.

- Burglars are targeting unoccupied (or what they think is unoccupied) houses. Usually, if they encounter someone in the house, they run. They usually go straight to the master bedroom for safes, jewelry and cash.

- Burglars usually enter through a rear glass door they shatter or find unlocked. If they want to get into your house, they will do so but anything you can do to make it more difficult may discourage them from continuing or it could take them longer (locking door to adding coating to windows).

- Cameras will not prevent crime but will help detectives in their investigations. Ring and Nest Cam cameras have great resolution. Officer Kimball has Ring at his home. For \$60 a year you can get unlimited storage.

- If you are taking an Uber or Lyft, walk away from your home and call it. Do not have them pick you up at your house.

- Different gangs from all over (Inland Empire and San Diego) are converging on Newport Beach. One gang consists of 18 to 25 year old Caucasians from Newport Beach. Most of them own nice cars but would put on paper plates. If someone just does not look like they should be in the neighborhood, call the police and tell them there is suspicious activity.

- If you have a safe, make sure it is bolted to the floor.
